The results of a small scale research project on, The Encouragement of Physical Activity in the Primary Care Setting; and on a General Medical Practioners Exercise Referral Scheme (GMPERS), with details of the current re-launch of the scheme on the island of Lewis, and other islands in the Outer Hebrides to follow.

The research proposals, piloting of the GP referral scheme, and the development of new medical and related protocols within a partnership framework with the local authority on the Western Isles will be outlined. Financial, ethical and cultural aspects will be covered alongside careful selection of appropriate staff and collaborative partners.
