To announce the formation of The Coalition for public Health Action

The Coalition for Public Health Action consists of five UK public health bodies: the Chartered Institute of Environmental Health, the Faculty of Public Health, the Royal Institute of Public Health, the Royal Society for the Promotion of Health and the UK Public Health Association.

The five organisations which make up the coalition for Public Health Action (hereby known as the coalition) agree to work together, pooling expertise, experience and resources, to present a united public health voice wherever appropriate and to advocate on issues central to the health of the UK population.
