*John was born and educated in the industrial West Midlands. He was a student Public Health Inspector at Dudley CBC until qualifying in 1970. He then moved to rural pastures & s Public Health Inspector with Wellington (Shropshire) DC, now part of Telford, and South Shropshire DC based in Ludlow. John left Shropshire as Senior EHO to come to Guernsey in 1979, becoming Deputy Chief EHO in 1986 and Chief EHO in 1999. He was appointed Director of Environmental Health and Pollution Regulation (Designate) in June 2004.*

*Tony was born in London and trained as a Public Health Inspector with the London Borough of Lewisham, qualifying in 1973. The following year he moved to the Maidstone Borough Council in Kent as an Environmental Health Officer and stayed until 1979 when he moved to Guernsey. Tony became Deputy Chief Environmental Health Officer in 1999.*
